Approach to Training

- Key experts train local practitioners in social work, psychology, physiotherapy & occupational therapy for the development of new types of social services
- Develop the capacity of local trainers working in the social protection sector to train others in set-up and development of new types of social services

Clinical Practice Placements

- Social Work
- Physiotherapy
- Occupational therapy

Why is this required?

- To develop the practice skills of existing practitioners and social work students

Facilitative and Experiential Training Methods

- Experience shows that the most effective training methods include facilitation and experiential learning
- This integrates theory with practice and ensures that practitioners gain knowledge in ***what they should know*** (theory) and equally as importantly ***how to do it in practice*** (practice skills).

Workforce Development

- Core Curriculum for Social Work Practitioners
 - Training in key theories which underpin social work across all client groups (theory)
 - Training in key skills for practitioners (practice)
- Specialist modules for each area of service delivery
 - Focussed service specific training (e.g. CWD, elderly, residential care, day care services etc.)
